CLM Claims College Update

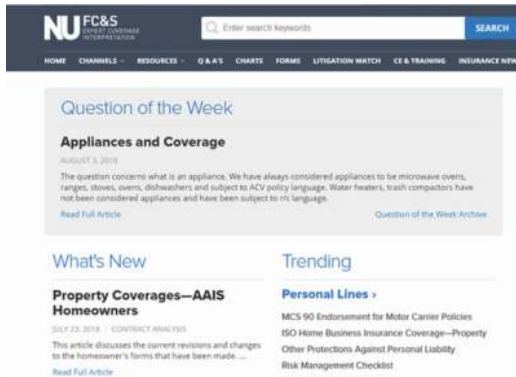
